## Care and Maintenance

Wool carpets are naturally stain resistant, which means that most stains can be easily removed using water and an approved spot cleaning spray. Never use bleach (chlorine) or any other chemicals on a wool carpet as this will disintegrate the fibre. Always test any cleaning solution in an inconspicuous area first to ensure it doesn't cause any damage. Samples should only be used as a guide to colour matching, slight colour variation possible
